Cleaning, disinfection and ventilation of the premises after each stay. Washing of bed linen by a professional service provider.




CHECK-OUT

No later than II a.m. in the morning. Please let us know your departure time from Shanta Beach Villa so that we can carry out your exit inventory. The exit inventory will be carried out when the keys are handed over. The security deposit will be returned to you within a maximum period of 7 working days after your departure and in the absence of rental damage. If rental damage is found, the security deposit will be returned to you within a maximum period of 2 months.

(The expenses incurred in compensation for the damage suffered will be deducted from the security deposit).







List of Equipments

Electricity: In the event of a power outage during your stay, the main electrical panel (Suites n° 1, 2, 3 and children's room) is located at the back of the house (garden side) at the location identified on the map " technical area ". Bungalows 1 and 2 are independent and have their own electrical panels.

Internet and Wifi code: The network is secure and the operator is ZEOP. Shanta_beach Code: Shantaguest. You will arrive on a reception platform dedicated to the villa and you will be asked to validate the general conditions and then enter your email address. In the use of this connection, you agree not to use the internet access made available to you for the purposes of reproduction, representation, making available or communication to the public of works or protected objects by copyright such as texts, images, photographs, musical works, audiovisual works, software and video games, without the authorization of the rights holders when this authorization is required.

Parking access: is done through the electric gate. Pedestrian access is also possible through the blue gate.

Washing machine & Drying machine: are located at the back of the house, on the garden side, at the level of the "Laundry room" identified on the plan.

Built-in dishwasher: is located at the kitchen level. A welcome kit containing a few washing tablets will be made available to you.

Traditional coffee machine: is located at the level of the kitchen bench. Possibility of using coffee beans or ground coffee.

Nespresso coffee machine: is located at the level of the kitchen bench. A welcome kit containing a few capsules will be offered to you.

TV: Press the ON key. You will then be able to access the villa's Netflix and Disney account.





Net: It is essential to respect the safety rules concerning the use of the housing net. The installation of the net has been designed to offer you a space for rest and relaxation, it is therefore not a trampoline and it is strictly forbidden to jump on the living net. Please also take off your shoes.

Shanta Beach Villa - Non Smoking: The entire villa is non-smoking for the comfort and well-being of all. We thank you in advance for smoking outside, making sure that the smoke does not enter the house. With high temperatures on the ground and in very dry vegetation, the combustion of the cigarette butt can quickly start a fire. Also, we thank you for not throwing your cigarette butts in the savannah which is part of the protected natural areas in Reunion.

Children's monitoring: For their safety, never leave your young children unattended. You are also asked to ensure that they respect the safety instructions (residential net, glass guardrails, petanque balls...).

Hygienic towels and tampons: it is imperative that you never flush your sanitary napkins and tampons down the toilet. The pipes are absolutely not intended for this use. Please use the trash can provided in the bathrooms.

Glass garde: For your safety, please do not lean on the glass guardrails.

Cushions: Please remember to bring in the cushions of the housing net at night and place them on the pool deck.

Anti mosquito spirals : The use of mosquito coils is strictly prohibited inside and outside the villa (pool beach areas, gratings included) because they can cause fires to start. Electric mosquito repellents are permitted indoors and outdoors.

Barbecue: a gas barbecue is available to you, please make sure that the gas is closed after the use of the barbecue.

Domestic animals : as hygiene measure, animals are formally prohibited on property.

Number of persons: You have indicated to the owner the number of people present at the villa, so you expressly agree not to exceed this authorized number. Shanta Beach Villa is a haven of peace, conducive to calm and relaxation. Also, you are asked to be discreet in the evening (after 10 p.m.), during the night, and early in the morning (before 7 a.m.). Please respect the neighborhood. Parties are not allowed.

Responsibility: As the tenant in title, you are personally responsible for all damage, loss or damage to the accommodation itself and what it contains and to all the facilities on the site, committed by yourself or the persons / parents who staying with you, or visiting you. You are therefore required to be insured by a resort-type insurance contract for these various risks. Respect for the rules of life: The tenants accept without reservation, irrevocably and definitively, the general rental conditions and these internal regulations. Failure to comply with one or more of the conditions of the rules of life attached to Shanta Beach Villa may result in the immediate termination of the rental at the fault of the tenant. The product of the rental will then remain definitively acquired by the owner.



Services & Benefits

Welcome: On your arrival, you will be welcomed by the household staff who will check you in and explain how the villa works.

Assistance during your stay: In case of emergency, you can count during your stay on the assistance of the Shanta Beach Villa team from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday. Please use the WhatsApp group that will be created for any correspondances and emergencies during your stay

The pre-filling of the refrigerator on request: On request and no later than 2 days before your arrival at the villa, we suggest that you pre-fill your fridge. If you wish to benefit from this service, we will send you a list as well as the quantity of articles that you will be able to choose. The invoice will be sent to you for payment + €60 service charge. Please note that additional costs are to be expected for all additional requests.

Cleaning & Linens: Daily Housekeeping (except on Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays) Check in, Check out cleanings and bed linens are included in the rental price. Bed sheets will be changed once a week for stays longer than 7 nights and shower towels every 3 days. A pool towel per person will be given to you and will be changed once a week for stays of more than 7 nights. Breakfasts & Dinners: Breakfast is not included in the rental price but can be organized. For breakfasts, your orders must be placed no later than the day before, before 12:00 and for dinners, 4 days in advance. Meals are not included in the rental price. For all your requests, please contact us. Rates on request and availability to be checked.

Our well-being services: If you want to be pampered during your stay, it is possible. Massages, facials, nail polish etc. can be organized at the villa. Rates on request and availability to be checked. Payment for the service on the day of the service.

Our Kréol language

In Reunion, the official language is French as it is spoken, written and taught in Metropolitan France.

Did you know?

Reunionese Creole, which obtained the status of regional language in 2014, cohabits with the French language and if it is not a question of denigrating one language in particular for the benefit of the other, it must nevertheless be emphasized that the Creole historically holds an important place in Reunionese society.

Known to be the language of Maloya, it was born from this need for communication between slaves of different origins and slaves with their masters. This fusion of influences has brought out a mixed language with French, Malagasy, African, Indian and Chinese roots, a real cultural melting pot. Creole is found everywhere, in literature, in music, on our local media and even in the schools where it is taught.

Highlighting it within the villa was therefore obvious. During your stay, you will not miss the wooden signs hung everywhere on which you will find colorful expressions and local proverbs written in Creole, sometimes tinged with poetry, sometimes tinged with humor. There is no doubt that this little linguistic journey concocted just for you will arouse your curiosity and the desire to know more about our rich and colorful Creole language.

The Madoi, Museum of Decorative Arts of the Indian Ocean

The Madoi, Museum of Decorative Arts of the Indian Ocean
The last coffee estate in all of France's overseas territories, the Maison Rouge
estate has stood the test of time from the 18th century to the present day,
preserving all traces of its location on the ground. This agricultural complex,
surrounded by deep ravines, is located on a set of terraces, on the edge of bad
land, and complies with the codes in force in the 16th century home economics
manuals, still in use in the 18th century. This remarkable ensemble has been
classified as a Historic Monument since 2004.

The Museum of Decorative Arts, labeled Museum of France, was established in the heart of the Maison Rouge estate in 2008. Among the promotion offers, the museum team offers guided tours through the discovery of the property, the "Bourbon Pointu" coffee plantation, as well as a temporary exhibition room where a scientific and cultural offer highlights a heritage collection of great interest, illustrating the major aesthetic currents that have influenced Europe and the Ocean Indian.

Siva Soupramanian Saint Paul Temple

A legend says that it is not advisable for a Tamil to take up residence in a place where there is no temple.

This explains why very early on (as early as 1828) the Indians organized a campaign for the construction of the temple of Saint Paul.

In 1876, several permit holders (free Indians) demanded authorization to establish a "pagoda", on land owned by Mr Laprade "at the end of the pond ». Following an exchange of letters, the temple was erected two to four years later.

The Siva Soupramanien temple is a vegetarian temple, but the temple has experienced a distant time of animal sacrifice.

GUANDI Temple:

Reunion has only four pagodas or temples despite the large Chinese community. On the heights of Terre-Sainte now stands the largest Guan Di temple in the entire Indian Ocean.

This magnificent building was built in the purest Chinese tradition and according to feng shui principles.

Its frame, ordered in China, was assembled by workers specially brought in from the Chinese provinces.

After 5 years of work, the temple dedicated to Guan Di, a warrior who became a god, was consecrated on August 14, 2017.

Excellent works allow to know more about this religion dedicated to the Gods, the Spirits and the Ancestors.
